- \_\_\_ 2) Submit BCC application (www.brunswickcc.edu - **enter "freshman" status & choose any major**)
- \_\_\_ 3) Submit official copy of current high school transcript to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 4) Submit copy of appropriate assessment scores to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 5) Submit signed "Career and College Promise" Authorization Form to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 6) Register in BCC course(s) listed within your specific program of study with Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 7) Pay insurance and technology fees (\$9.50 or \$17.50) (BCC Business office on 1<sup>st</sup> floor in Building A – or call (910) 755-7318)
- \_\_\_ 8) If needed, purchase college textbooks (exception for CTE cosmetology and welding "cluster" courses; Please note: Cosmetology students must purchase their own cosmetology kit, all black uniforms & shoes)
- \_\_\_ 9) Acquire BCC ID (BCC Library on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in Building A)
- \_\_\_ 10) Acquire BCC parking decal (BCC Student Services Department on 1<sup>st</sup> floor in Building A)
