**New student eligibility check list:**

- \_\_\_ 1) 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student
- \_\_\_ 2) Have cumulative weighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher
- \_\_\_ 3) Demonstrate college readiness on one of the following assessments (must score within the listed ranges in English, reading and mathematics):

**Note:** An 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who does not demonstrate college readiness on an approved assessment may be provisionally enrolled in the College Transfer Pathway. To qualify for Provisional Status, a student must meet the following criteria:

- a. Have a cumulative weighted GPA of 3.5;
- b. Have completed two years of high school English with a grade of 'C' or higher;
- c. Have completed high school Algebra II (or higher math) with a grade of 'C' or higher;
- d. Obtain the written approval of the high school principal or his/her designee; and,
- e. Obtain the written approval of the community college president or his/her designee.

A Provisional Status student may register only for college mathematics (MAT) and college English (ENG) courses within the chosen program of study area. To be eligible to register for other courses in the program of study area, the student must first successfully complete mathematics and English courses with a grade of 'C' or higher.

**New student enrollment and registration check list:**

- \_\_\_ 1) Determine program area: Associate in Arts (P1012C); Associate in Engineering (P1052C); or Associate in Science (P1042C)
- \_\_\_ 2) Submit BCC application (www.brunswickcc.edu - **enter "freshman" status & choose any major**)
- \_\_\_ 3) Submit official copy of current high school transcript to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 4) Submit copy of appropriate assessment scores to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 5) Submit signed "Career and College Promise" Authorization Form to Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 6) Register in BCC course(s) listed within your specific program of study with Jerry Smith – BCC
- \_\_\_ 7) Pay insurance and technology fees (\$9.50 or \$17.50) (BCC Business office on 1<sup>st</sup> floor in Building A – or call (910) 755-7318)
- \_\_\_ 8) If needed, purchase college textbooks (possible exception for some College Transfer courses – check with your local high school)
- \_\_\_ 9) Acquire BCC ID (BCC Library on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in Building A)
- \_\_\_ 10) Acquire BCC parking decal (BCC Student Services Department on 1<sup>st</sup> floor in Building A)
