



DEVELOPMENTAL AND CURRICULUM COURSE
CO-ENROLLMENT

POLICY

Under specific circumstances, some students may be eligible to co-enroll in developmental and curriculum-level English.

Students who place into curriculum English (ENG 111) on the writing portion of the English placement test and place into the highest-level developmental English course (ENG 095) on the reading portion of the placement test are eligible to enroll in ENG 111 but are required to co-enroll in developmental Reading (DRE 099), a reading and writing skills lab intended specifically for this population. Similarly, students who place into curriculum ENG 111 on the reading portion of the English placement test and place into ENG 095 on the writing portion of the placement test are eligible to enroll in ENG 111 but are required to co-enroll in DRE 099.

Not every ENG 111 section has an accompanying DRE 099 course. Students who meet the parameters outlined above must enroll in specific ENG 111 courses tied to ENG 099 lab courses and, in planning their schedules, allow for the five weekly contact hours that are required for ENG 111 and DRE 099 co-enrollment.

Students may not co-enroll in developmental math and curriculum math courses.
