

OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH POLICY

POLICY

Brunswick Community College adheres to all policy requirements and guidelines as set forth by the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (PL-91-596).

Policies and procedures developed shall be designed to provide not only a safe physical working and learning environment but also an atmosphere of safety awareness through safety education and training.

PROCEDURE

The College maintains a Chemical Hygiene Plan and appoints a Chemical Hygiene Officer for oversight and compliance of such plan.

The College maintains a Hazard Communication Plan and appoints a Hazard Communication Coordinator for oversight and compliance of such plan.

The College utilizes the Environmental Health and Safety Institute of Blue Ridge Community College to supplement annual staff safety training requirements related to OSHA compliance such as, but not limited to: fire extinguisher, blood borne pathogens, electrical and workplace safety.
