**BRUNSWICK COMMUNITY COLLEGE
TOBACCO-FREE COLLEGE**

- Authority. North Carolina General Statute 115D-20.1 provides local community college guidance and authority regarding the use of any tobacco product on college property and in college vehicles and facilities owned, leased, or operated by the institution.
- Definition. Tobacco products are any product made or derived from tobacco that is intended for human consumption.” Examples include cigarettes, e-cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, dip, smokeless tobacco or spit tobacco snuff, or any other items containing or reasonably resembling tobacco or tobacco products.
- Policy. Brunswick Community College is committed to providing its students, employees, and visitors with a safe and healthy environment. Smoking is recognized as a significant health risk to both the smoker and the non-smoker as well as a safety hazard to the College. The use of tobacco products is prohibited on all Brunswick Community College property and in vehicles owned, leased, or operated by the institution.
- Allowance. The use of tobacco products is prohibited.

Littering is a misdemeanor defined in North Carolina General Statute 14.399.
