Must have the following in the Admission's Office by the end of the application period:

- Official high school/GED/AHS transcripts with a GPA of 2.2 or higher\*, or an ACT Math score of 20 or higher, or MAT 003 (with a grade of P2 or P3) \_\_\_\_\_
- Official high school transcripts with a GPA of 2.2 or higher\*, or ACT ENG score of 16 or higher, or ACT reading score of 20 or higher, or ENG 002 (with a grade of P1) \_\_\_\_\_
- All official college transcripts from all colleges and universities previously attended \_\_\_\_\_
- Students having graduated longer than 10 years will need to take the EdReady placement test \_\_\_\_\_

2). Must be on the Nurse Aide I Board of Registry by the date specified in the PN Admissions brochure (Contact Continuing Ed. for next NAI class) \_\_\_\_\_

Applicants are chosen based on a point system. Students who have successfully taken most of their related courses with a C or better by the end of the fall semester will have a greater chance of being selected.

Additional points are given for students living in Brunswick County, currently taking courses at BCC, and having taken a higher level math than the above requirement, and/or an ACA 122 course with a C or better.
