Program Cost:

Registration Fee: \$180.00 (Waived if eligible under NCCCS Fee Waiver)

Insurance Fee: \$2.50 (Accident Insurance)

Total Due at Registration: \$182.50 (Unless covered under NCCCS Fee Waiver)
