Upon successful completion of the Information Systems certificate, graduates should be able to:

- Use computers to process, manage, and communicate information as evaluated by the faculty via a 100-point rubric with a score of at least 70
- Demonstrate their knowledge of computer operations and terminology, operating systems, database, networking, security, and technical support as evaluated on various course exams with a score of 70% or higher
- Analyze job requirements for entry-level positions found with businesses, educational systems, and governmental agencies
