NATURAL HAIR SPECIALIST PATHWAY

Natural Hair Care Specialist is a 300-hour course designed to teach how to care for natural hair without the use of chemicals such as perms/ relaxers and hair color. The style techniques include braiding, twisting, wrapping, extending and locking natural hair. The coursework also includes teaching the proper health, safety, and sanitation procedures to avoid spreading infections. The students will be able to apply their skills to clients who visit the clinic. After successfully completing the course, the students will be able to sit for the North Carolina State Board of Cosmetic Art's exam to become a licensed Natural Hair Care Specialist.

Required To Register

- Must be at least 18 years old
- High-school diploma or equivalency (GED)
- Proficiency in English
- · Clean criminal record
